Special features of these libraries comprise the presence of a book bank with facility of lending books to

the members. The book bank possesses a large number of reference book, Journals, research reports,

children educational aids and textbooks for National Open School students. The library also maintains

newspaper clipping on various issues related to child welfare and child development started with the initial

assistance of Rajiv Gandhi Foundation. The Project has also been founded by the Krishna. Bihari Vajpayee

Trust Directorate of education, Govt. of India and NORAD. In this Project Prayas run 61 libraries in India

and 20 in Delhi. The objective of running library programme at different NFE centers of Prayas is Primarily

aimed at growth of children's development needless to mention is here that the library programme is going
